**OUR MISSION:** The Red Envelope Giving Circle (REGC) is committed to creating positive social change in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area through philanthropic support of community projects that improve the lives of Asian and Pacific Islander (API) LGBTQ people and communities.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** REGC's priority is to fund San Francisco Bay Area API-LGBTQ-led projects that directly engage members of the San Francisco Bay Area API-LGBTQ communities in making transformative, positive, social change within their own communities. The number of grants awarded during this cycle is contingent on available funding. *The grant amount is up to \$3,000*. Projects funded in the last grant cycle are not eligible to apply this year and must wait one year before submitting another grant proposal. Organizations and individuals funded in the last grant cycle may apply again this year if the proposal is for a new or different project.

**FISCAL SPONSORSHIP:** All applicants must have a not-for-profit 501c(3) status or have a fiscal sponsor with such status. Please contact us if securing fiscal sponsorship poses a barrier to your application.

**IMPORTANT DATES:** Please submit your grant proposal no later than 11:59pm PDT, October 1, 2017. Late proposals, including late proof of fiscal sponsorship, will not be considered. Notification of Grant Awards will be made by December 1, 2017. Please save the date and plan to be present at our Grantees' Presentation Ceremony scheduled for February 11, 2017. Please note that grantees are also required to submit a short video, graphic/poster, or written piece about their projects that will be presented at the Grantees' Presentation Ceremony.
